



Prekindergarten Invitation to Apply Available vacancies 2010-11

Guilford County Schools serves about 1200 prekindergarten children in 47 elementary schools across the county and is funded through Title I funds, More At Four funds, local funds and district funds. The initial application period ended April 23, 2010.

You are encouraged to apply at any time if your child will be four years old on or before August 31, 2010, and will not be kindergarten age eligible. Should a vacancy occur in a school you list on this application, the prek office will contact you to schedule a screening appointment to determine your child's eligibility if there is not a current wait list for the school.

- Eligible children are offered placement in vacant positions throughout the school year based on a prioritized list of need for school readiness.
- You must be a resident of Guilford County.
- Your child must qualify based on the comprehensive screening results.
